A) Internet Project - Use the Internet and locate the answers for the following items:

- ◆ Auto Insurance: Find an estimate for auto insurance with comprehensive and collision coverage for your vehicle. - ◆ Social Security: Find out what your retirement benefits will be at 62 and at full retirement.
