- Q Go to the following web site: **www.wois.org**
- Q Click **Enter Site Key** text box on the left hand side of the page.
- Q Enter the following Site Key Code: bwt649
- Q Click on **“Assessments”** on the left navigation panel.
- Q Click on **“Interest Profiler.”**
- Q Click **“Start.”**
- Q When you are finished responding to all the statements, Click on **“Go to Next Page.”** If you have missed answering any of the questions, the page will appear with unanswered selections marked in red. Respond to those statements and Click on **“Go to Next Page.”**
- Q When you finish answering the questions on all 5 pages, type your name in the box, then click on **“Finish.”**
- Q Save to your student space on the network and print the final page that has the careers showing your interest areas.
- Q Find your highest score under **“Your Score.”**
- Q Click on the related careers to the right of the highest score under **“Related WOIS Careers.”**
- Q Click on an occupation that interests you. If you don't find one you are interested in, click on **“Back to Results”** and click on the related careers to the right of the next highest score and so on.
- Q Read about **three occupations** that interest you the most.
- Q In a separate Word Document record the following **for each** occupation you have chosen:

- Q List the **Job title**.
- Q List 3 specific **advantages** to this job.

- Q List the current **employment numbers** (number of people currently employed in this job).
- Q Describe the **educational requirement** for this job.
- Q Describe **Salary/Wages**.
- Q List **Working Conditions**.
- Q Describe the **Future Outlook** for this job.
- Q List **three specific job opportunities** for this job right now.
- Q **Summarize** why you chose this job as a potential career choice and how it will fit in with your future lifestyle.
